- 501 THE ASHES OF 2001 - THE PONTING-MILLER ASHES**
 The ashes collected by Ricky Ponting and Colin Miller after a ritual burning of three bails in a tray of kerosene in 2001, after the final Test Match at The Oval, with Australia winning the series 4-1. *As noted in Steve Waugh's Ashes Diary 2001, the Australian cricket team for the 2001 tour of England continued the earlier tradition of creating their own trophy for the mythical ashes. At The Oval Test match in August 2001, three bails were burnt in a tray of kerosene by Ricky Ponting and Colin Miller. Colin Miller retained the embers. Housed in a beautiful wood-turned urn, made from huon pine with a blackwood top, marked on base "Designed by Tony Peake, P.D.Joinery, 2008", with silver plaque engraved "THE ASHES, 2001". Ex Colin Miller collection.*
 Despite the popular misconception, the Darnley urn and velvet bag are not the only Ashes trophies. Over the years, there have been a number of items created to embody the concept of "the mythical ashes". Here is a list of those encountered during research by Melbourne Cricket Club's librarian David Studham. The first two were made for cricketers as humorous representations of the continuing joke about "the ashes". The later items were all constructed to represent some kind of trophy to record the cricketers' victory in the ongoing contest for the mythical ashes:

Border, Allan Robert

Born: 27 July 1955 **Left-hand batsman, left-arm orthodox slow bowler**

Cricketers of greater talent and flair have represented Australia, but few have had greater resource, application and courage than Allan Border. In gathering more Test runs and caps than any other player, he set marks that only a batsman of astonishing consistency, pluck and luck will be able to surpass. Only Don Bradman can have been more esteemed at the end of his Test-playing days than the stocky left-hander; in Border's case there was as much affection as admiration for the way in which he weathered a barren period for Australia in international cricket. He was awarded the Order of Australia and named Australian of the Year in 1990 and his 10th and final summer as national captain in 1993/94, a Testimonial season, was accompanied by numerous spontaneous demonstrations of public allegiance. Border can also be regarded as Australia's original professional cricketer.

Emerging as WSC was compelling the ACB to pay its Test cricketers as full-time professional sportsmen, he was probably the first of his ilk to be able to rely on the game exclusively for his income. By the end of his Test career, furthermore, he was the best paid cricketer in Australian history.

Educated like Ian Craig, Graeme Hole and Peter Philpott at North Sydney Boys' High School, Border began his career as an all-rounder who bowled left-arm spin and batted assertively in the lower middle order. His promise was spasmodic, however, and he did not excel at schoolboy level. Nor could he command a regular first-team place in his first four seasons at Sydney's Mosman-Middle Harbour Cricket Club. It was captain-coach Barry Knight, a former English Test all-rounder then running an indoor cricket school, who finally convinced Border to take his cricket talent seriously by enrolling for one-to-one winter tuition in 1975. After outstanding grade form in the ensuing summer, he was selected for the NSW Sheffield Shield squad.

Throughout Border's career he was often expected to fill sudden breaches. The first was the absence of several key NSW players on international duty in January 1977, which expedited his first-class selection against Qld. Within two years – Australian ranks being denuded by defections to Kerry Packer – Border was capped as a 23-year-old for the Third Test of 1978/79 against England (making 29 and nought) and undertook his first tour (the 1979 World Cup). As other highly regarded contemporaries like Peter Toohey, Gary Cosier and Graham Yallop faltered during that tumultuous time. Border laid the foundations of a substantial career. His average after 10 Test innings was 60.29, including centuries against India and Pakistan. Border then made a tenacious 115 in Perth against England in 1979 in his second Test as a member of the Test team reconstituted after the rapprochement between WSC and the ACB. And at Lahore in 1979/80 Border registered the unprecedented feat of a bracket of 150s – 150 not out and 153 in a combined time of 10 hours with seven sixes and 32 fours – before returning to Australia to accept a lucrative offer to relocate in Qld.

Border at the crease did not suggest a player of classical technique, but his method observed all the correct precepts. His judgment on off-stump was precise, the bat came through straight, and he was quick to reprove errors of length with cuts and pulls reflecting his years as a junior baseballer. Border's cover drive, when circumstances allowed, was also lovely to behold. The unifying force in Border's batting, however was concentration. Few have had deeper reserves. He played countless innings of solitary defiance, often in losing causes and handicapped by injury. Although Australia was beaten three to one in England in 1981, Border batted for 15 hours in the last two matches without getting out, despite a finger broken in the field. He was Man of the Match in the Adelaide Test of 1982, though his stoical double of 78 and 126 was insufficient to deny a West Indian victory. One of Border's best-remembered hands, also in a losing cause, came as that year ended at the MCG against England. Suffering his first prolonged barren patch, Border had only just made the side. He was joined late on the fourth day by last man Jeff Thomson with Australia 74 runs from victory, but, by bold strokeplay and nerveless manipulation of the strike, resisted for two hours and 70 runs before his partner fell on the final day.

The most important breach that opened during Border's career was that caused by the retirements of Greg Chappell, Dennis Lillee and Rod Marsh in 1984. At first he was called upon to fill the role of vice-captain and key batsman in the West Indies in March-April 1984, which he did with

521 runs at 74.42 in a heavily defeated side. After two drubbings by the West Indies at home. Border was abruptly left with the Australian captaincy by the resignation of the forlorn Kim Hughes at the Gabba on 27 November 1984. Border's first 30 months as leader were bleak. Australia lost or drew the first seven series under his command and, although he continued to stand head and shoulders above his batting peers, Border did not seem especially assimilative of the skills of leadership. Criticisms were levelled at his defensive instincts, poor rapport with bowlers, mercurial temper and even his friendly relations with English cricketers. It was not until the 1987 World Cup in India and Pakistan – when Border led a well-drilled and organised team with the aid of newly appointed coach Bob Simpson and vice-captain Geoff Marsh – that Australia prospered under his command. Though his side was regarded as a rank outsider, Australia suffered only one narrow defeat before winning the final against England at Eden Gardens. Border led his side inventively and was exemplary in the field – always a splendid catcher at second slip, and with a fine out-field arm honed at baseball. He executed numerous run-outs in Limited Overs cricket from a position he pioneered at short mid-wicket.

Even then, there were setbacks. Border was censured a year later when Australia toured Pakistan and, like many sides before and since, began to blame partisan umpiring and poor pitches for Australia's performance. Although Border made a poised 113 not out at Faisalabad, he, Simpson and manager Colin Egar were criticised for overreacting to mild provocation. There is no doubt that, when fortune eluded him, Border could cut a surly figure. When a magazine journalist coined Border's epithet of 'Captain Grumpy', the name stuck. Border would later gain the dubious distinction of being the first Test player proscribed by an ICC referee for unbecoming on-field behaviour; he compounded the offence by refusing to appear before the disciplinary hearing.

Border's captaincy turned the corner decisively at the moment he decided to give freer rein to his combative instincts. Having lost three Tests to the West Indies at Brisbane, Perth and Melbourne at the end of 1988, Border roused his team to a reversal at the SCG with what *Wisden* described as 'an all-round performance seldom surpassed as a captain in Test cricket': 75, 16 not out and 11/96 on a turning pitch, with his disused left-armers. Hardened by his home summer, and driven by memories of a wretched Ashes record, Border then led an unblinkingly hostile campaign in England in 1989. A side that had blended steadily under his leadership, including Marsh, Steve Waugh, David Boon, Merv Hughes, Dean Jones and Ian Healy, was completed by the arrival as an accomplished opening bat of Mark Taylor, and the hand-some four-to-nil victory margin redressed many past indignities. Having won six Tests and lost 13 to the end of 1988, Border's men won 16 Tests and lost only three over the next four years. Enhanced by the arrivals of Mark Waugh in 1991, Shane Warne in 1992 and Michael Slater in 1993, Australia retained the Ashes at home and in England. By Border's international retirement in March 1994 – by which time he had captained in a record 93 Tests for 32 victories, 22 defeats, a tie and 38 draws and in 178 one-day internationals for 107 wins, 67 defeats, a tie and three no-result games – Australia rated behind only the West Indies. The nucleus of the side Border had cultivated would within a year win the Frank Worrell Trophy. Border's 11 174 Test runs at 50.56 attest to his consistency, as his record 64 Test century partnerships reflect his renown as the quintessential team player. His thirst for the game – at a time when many players complained of the banality of constant competition – was unquenchable: never did he balk at a tour, undertaking 28 trips for Australia and playing 153 Tests consecutively. Having played village cricket for Downend in 1977 and for East Lancashire in the Lancashire League in 1978, Border also played two productive seasons of county cricket with Essex in 1986 and 1988. Border's swansong was also poignant. He opted - at an age when most Australian cricketers have settled for slippers and microphone – to pad up for Qld in the 1994/95 and 1995/96 Sheffield Shield seasons. His 911 runs at an average of 65 in 1994/95 underwrote his adopted State's first Shield victory, confirmation – if it was needed – of his status as a latterday folk hero. Laird, Bruce Malcolm

Born 21 November 1950 Right-hand batsman

Bruce Laird, a man of short stature, earned a reputation as a courageous batsman, withstanding the fierce pace of the West Indian bowling in the late 1970s and early 1980s. He was a determined occupier of the crease whose batting featured neat deflections and the occasional fluent on-drive. Laird toured England in 1975 but did not play a Test. His decision to join WSC delayed his Test debut until 1979/80. In his first Test, against the West Indies at Brisbane, Laird batted brilliantly, scoring 92 and 75 – the highest aggregate without a century of any batsman in his first Test. Compact and solid in backfoot defence, Laird also recorded his finest Limited Overs International performance against the powerful West Indies pace battery in Sydney in 1981/82, when he scored a match-winning 117. Laird was the first Australian opener to carry his bat through a completed Limited Overs International innings: 91 not out (out of 4/206) against Pakistan in 1982. For almost a decade Laird was one of the finest exponents of batting against fast bowling. He completed his career as a

middle-order specialist with the WA team, and bowled out a member of the 1983/84 Sheffield Shield-winning team along with his close friend Dennis Lillee. The pair had opted not to tour the Caribbean with a young team led by Kim Hughes. [Source: "A to Z of Australian Cricketers"]

Colin "Funky" Miller

A consummate cricketing journeyman, Colin Miller made his mark with several teams in Australia, Europe and Asia as a spirited right arm bowler, belligerent lower order batsman, and wholehearted fieldsman. From his cricketing origins in Melbourne's western suburbs until the late 1990s, Miller's career was built on his reputation as a strongly built right arm paceman who could move the ball both ways and who had the capacity to vary his pace cleverly.

In the latter part of his career, however, he made a staggering transformation to his game which saw him rise from being a well-regarded state player to an Australian first-class record breaker and international surprise packet.

Almost unbelievably, Miller's decision in a Hobart club game to revert from bowling pace to off-spin (on account of a niggling ankle injury) and to thereafter mix both styles of bowling was the catalyst for an astonishing succession of events. Among the more notable of these were his haul of 12/119 against South Australia in January 1998 (an all-time record for a Tasmanian bowler in a Sheffield Shield match); his rewriting in 1997-98 of 'Chuck' Fleetwood-Smith's 63-year old record for the highest number of wickets taken in a Shield season; and his stunning emergence in his mid-30s as a tremendously reliable performer for Australia in the international arena. Whilst he surprised some observers by opening the bowling as a paceman and later returning to the crease as an off-spinner who extracted considerable bounce and turn, it must be noted

that it would be difficult to identify many first-class bowlers who have struck with anywhere near the same degree of consistency as he did. That he was voted 'Test Player of the Year' for 2000-01 for a team which dominated world cricket tells its own tale about his effectiveness. It's not only for the frequent changes to the colour of his hair since January 2001 that Miller will therefore be renowned.

Miller announced his retirement from first-class cricket in July 2002. He will surely long be remembered as one of the more versatile players ever to represent Australia and one of the country's most amazing first-class success stories. [Source: Cricinfo]

Who was Keith?

Future generations of first-class cricketers might well wonder who the “Keith's Corner” plaque in the home team dressing room at the WACA Ground refers to. Keith Miller? Keith Stackpole?

No, try Keith Attree, who gained legendary status among WA's cricketers for the effective manner in which he carried out his role as home team room attendant.

Be it providing ice packs and drinks or making sure gear was in the right place – perhaps even offering a quiet word of encouragement – Attree was a permanent yet subdued part of the dressing room environment.

He never sought plaudits for his work but the players so appreciated his presence and his effort that they requested the WACA's committee forever commemorate Keith's Corner.
