That stamp is one of 4 mint examples known and is listed in the ACSC [2004] as 43c where it is valued at \$25,000. Another mint example of this variety, but uniquely, perforated OS, and with a missing perforation, brought A\$19,500 in the same New York auction, where it was listed as Lot 403].
