He was one of the most radical and colourful figures in the politics of colonial Victoria, and made the most determined efforts to break the power of the Victorian Legislative Council, the stronghold of the landowning class. Berry served three different times as Premier of Victoria: 7 August 1875-20 October 1875, 21 May 1877-5 March 1880 and 3 August 1880- 9 July 1881.
