On his first jump, he became the first man to legally pass the 18-metre barrier (18.16 m/59 feet 7 inches). That record lasted for about 20 minutes. **The Ross Edwards Collection**

*Born into a cricketing family Ross Edwards began his career as a wicketkeeper-batsman for Claremont-Cottesloe, the club of his father Edward Keane Edwards. Edwards made his first class debut in 1964/65. His wicketkeeping opportunities were restricted first by the presence of Gordon Becker and then later Rod Marsh, so Edwards concentrated on developing his batting talents, with outstanding results. By the end of the 1960's 'Roscoe' Edwards was a combative free-scoring middle order batsman who eventually, in 1972, through consistent run-getting forced his way into Ian Chappell's 1972 England touring party. In his second test*

*at Trent Bridge Edwards scored 170 not out becoming a regular and loyal member of Chappell's team. He scored a second Test century against England in Perth during the 1974 season, and returned to England again in 1975 before retiring the same year. Edwards returned to cricket during the Packer upheaval and captained the Cavaliers on their country tours 1977-79 and briefly returned to Sheffield Shield to play for and captain NSW. Edwrads went on to become a Channel 9 executive in Sydney. Ross Edwards played 20 Tests 1972-75*

*Jack Collins played 154 games for Footscray 1950-58. One of the best full-forwards of his era, Collins came from Yarraville. He played eight games for Victoria between 1952 and 1957 and won Footscray's best and fairest in 1951 and 1952. He was the Leagues leading goalkicker with 84 in 1954 and 74 in 1957. Collins had uncanny goal sense, was a good mark and had natural cleverness. His high marking equipped him for either of the key position posts and he also played some great football in his early years at centre half back. Coach Charlie Sutton put him there when two key defenders left the club. He was a long kick for goal and booted 7 in his club's first (and only) premiership win in 1954. Collins had missed the finals a year earlier because of a suspension late in the season and it had a serious impact on the Bulldogs' finals chances. In 1954 he was involved in a rare incident when he kicked 2 goals without the ball being returned to the centre.
