When ANA ceased operations, **Boulton** worked for Ulm on his Trans-Tasman airmail services. In Dec. 1933, Faith in Australia left Richmond NSW for New Zealand with Ulm (Pilot), Scotty Allan (Navigator) and **Boulton** (Engineer), as well as the first 2 women passengers to cross the Tasman by air. **Boulton** also crewed the first airmail service to & from New Guinea and Papua. For his participation on the pioneering airmail flights with Charles Ulm, and for services to aviation, Bob **Boulton** was awarded the MBE in 1976.
